- **1** 1 In the beginning, when God began to create the heavens and the earth, 2 the earth had no form and was void; darkness was over the deep and the Spirit of God hovered over the waters.
- ³ God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. ⁴ God saw that the light was good and he separated the light from the darkness. ⁵ God called the light 'Day' and the darkness 'Night'. There was evening and there was morning: the first day.

The sons of Israel listed their names according to their clans and families, and one by one the names of all men of twenty years and over were recorded and counted. 19 As Yahweh had commanded. Moses took a census of them in the desert of Sinai. 20 When the tribe of Reuben, Israel's firstborn, had been listed by clans and families, the names of all the males of twenty years and over, able to give military service, were recorded one by one. 21 The total of these for the tribe of

Reuben was 46,500.

22 When the tribe of Simeon had been listed by clans and families, the names of all the males of twenty years and over, able to give military service, were recorded one by one. 23 The total of these for the tribe of Simeon was
