The Add Process

Automatic Adding

Here you can control how calibre will read metadata from the files you add to it. calibre can either read metadata from the contents of the file, or from the filename.

☒ Read metadata from file contents rather than file name

☐ Swap author first and last name

☒ When using the "Copy to Library" action to copy books between libraries, preserve the date

☐ Mark newly added books

☐ Automatically convert added books to the current output format

☐ Ignore duplicate incoming formats

☐ Automerge added books if they already exist in the calibre library:
