CONCERN: Boys are lagging behind girls in literacy

ALMOST a third of 14-year-olds in the region are not able to read as well as they should, test results revealed yesterday.

YOUR BOARD

And boys in the county are failing to measure up to their female counterparts in literacy, with up to 17% more girls than boys reaching the expected level five in the Key Stage 3 tests.

Around one in four students fell short of the standards expected of their age group in the English national curriculum tests.

For writing, the failure rate dropped to one in five. But despite the worrying literacy results, the number of 14-year-olds achieving the expected level five in the region has surpassed the national averages in all the Key Stage 3 tests.


