

How to recover an EPUB file edited in Sigil after a power outage?*

^{*} If you're lucky and you are working on Windows




- Run Sigil
- Go to Preferences » General Settings » Advanced
- Look at your set temporary folder




Here you have two options:

- 1. If you see there
 <SIGIL_DEFAULT_TEMP_HOME>
 Press Win+R (Run), input %TMP%
 and press Enter.
 An Explorer window will open with your temp folder.
- A different folder path will be written there (copy it to clipboard)
 Press Win+R (Run), paste full folder path from Preferences window and press Enter.
 An Explorer window will open with your temp folder.



- Find folder with name **Sigil-XXXXXX**
- If there are many such folders find one that will have the date at the time of your power outage or a moment before that moment.



- Go to folder **Sigil-XXXXXX**
- Select all files and folders
- Right mouse button » Context menu
 Send to » Compressed folder (zip)

...or use your favourite application for create zip archive...

- Then will created new archive file with name **Sigil-XXXXXX.zip**
- Change extension in this file to .epub
- Move this file to your working folder and open Sigil-XXXXXX.epub file in Sigil.

If you were lucky – you got your file back.
