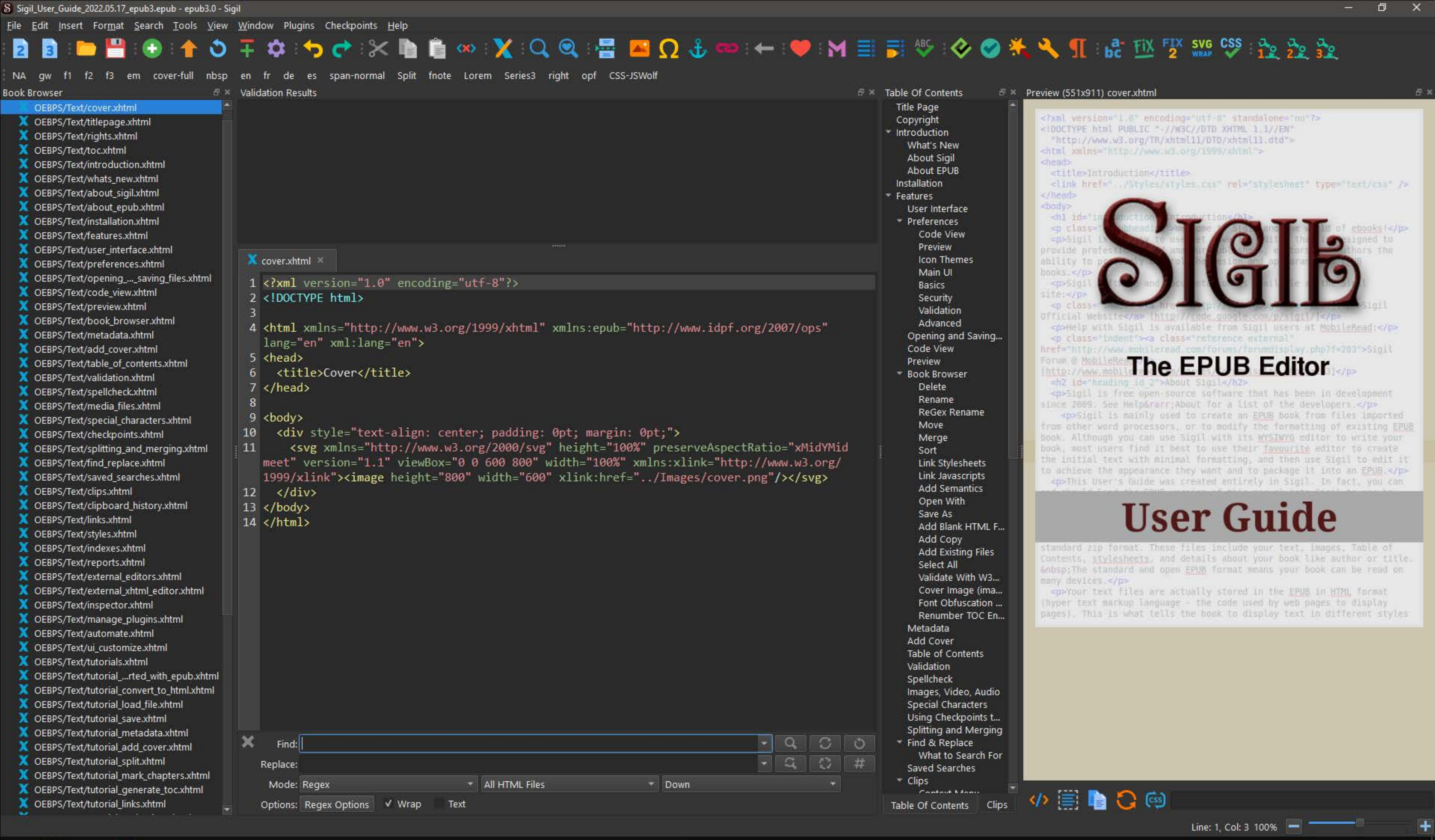
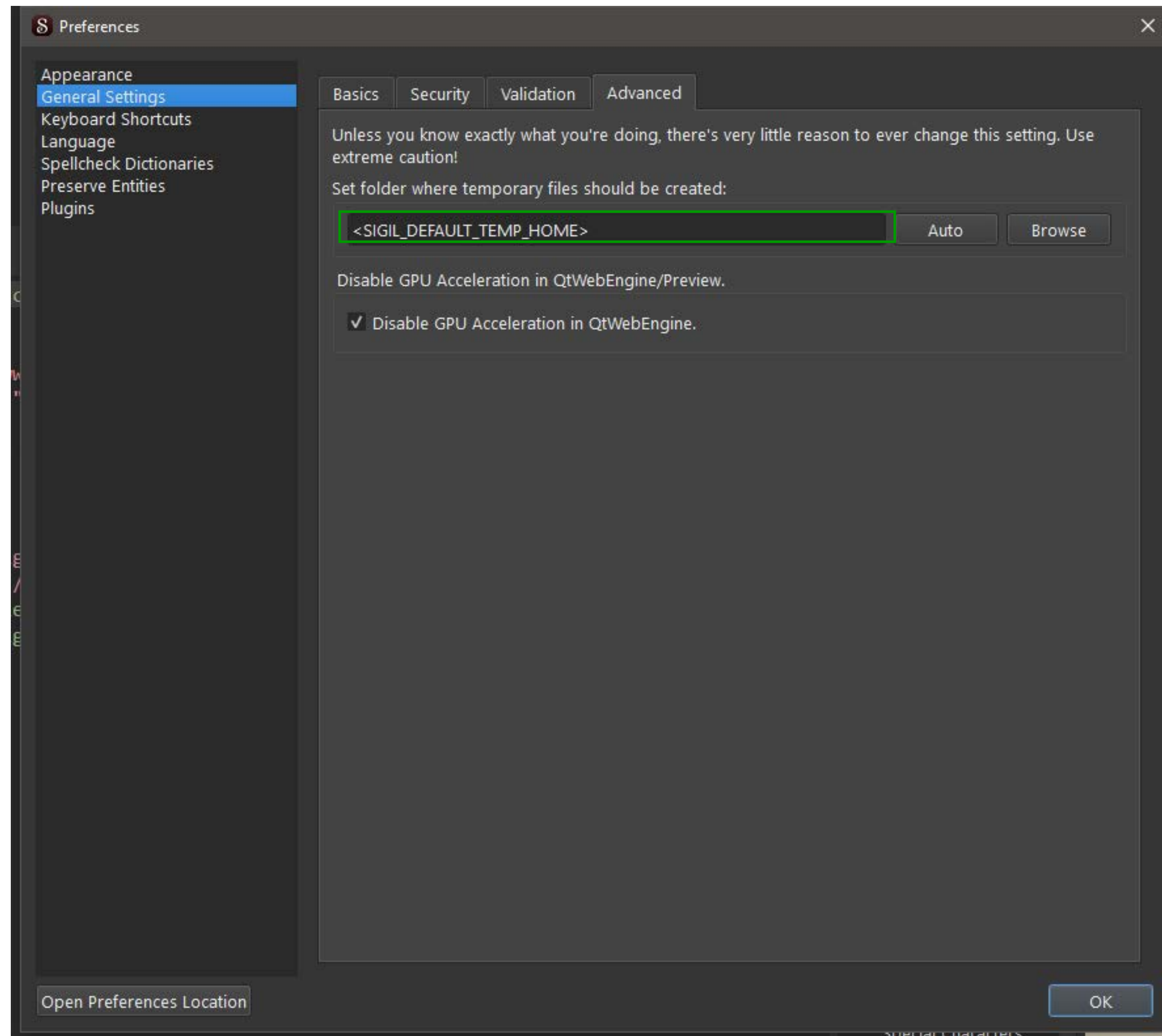


How to recover an EPUB file edited in Sigil after a power outage?*

** If you're lucky and you are working on Windows*

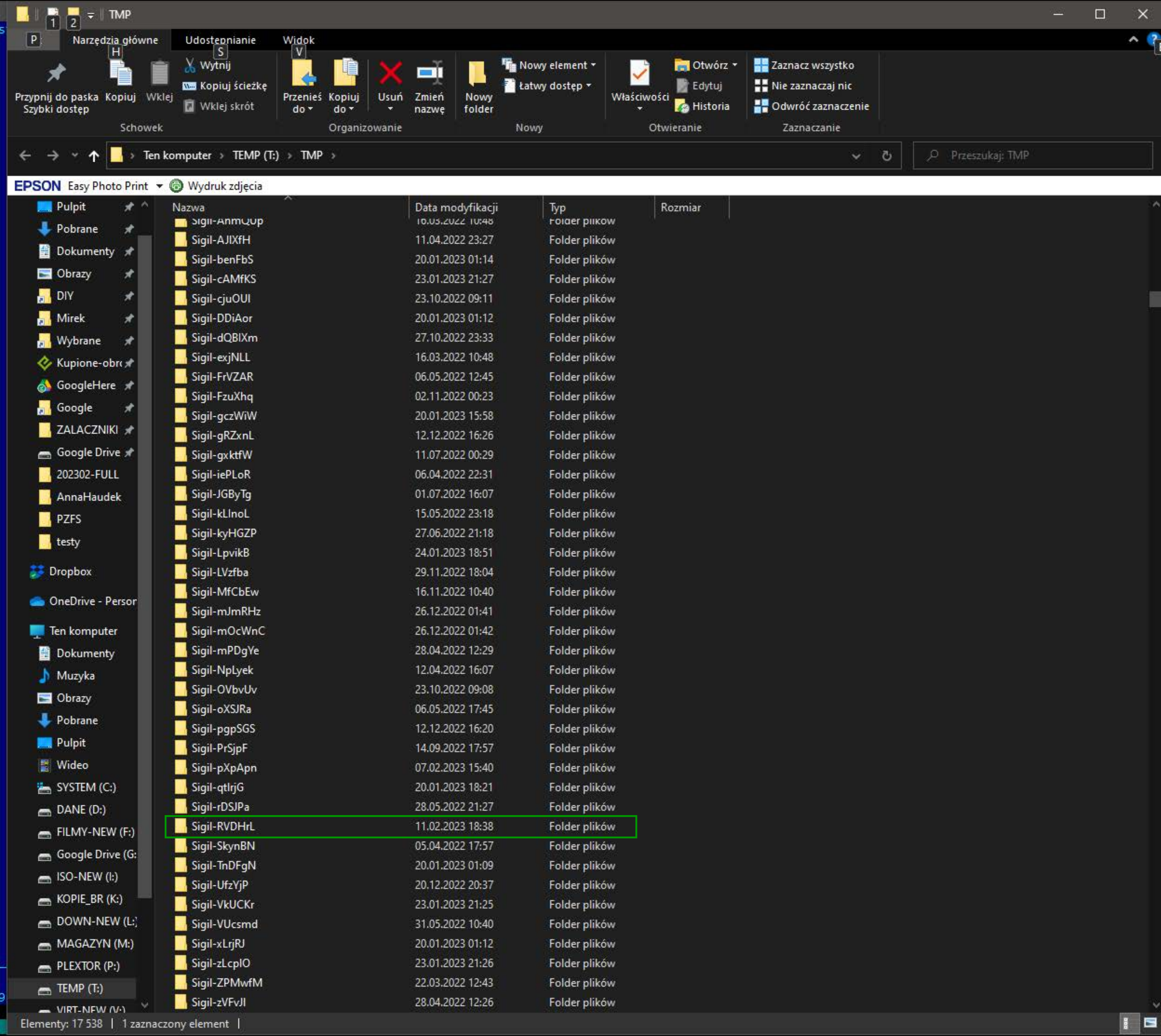


- Run **Sigil**
- Go to **Preferences » General Settings » Advanced**
- Look at your set temporary folder

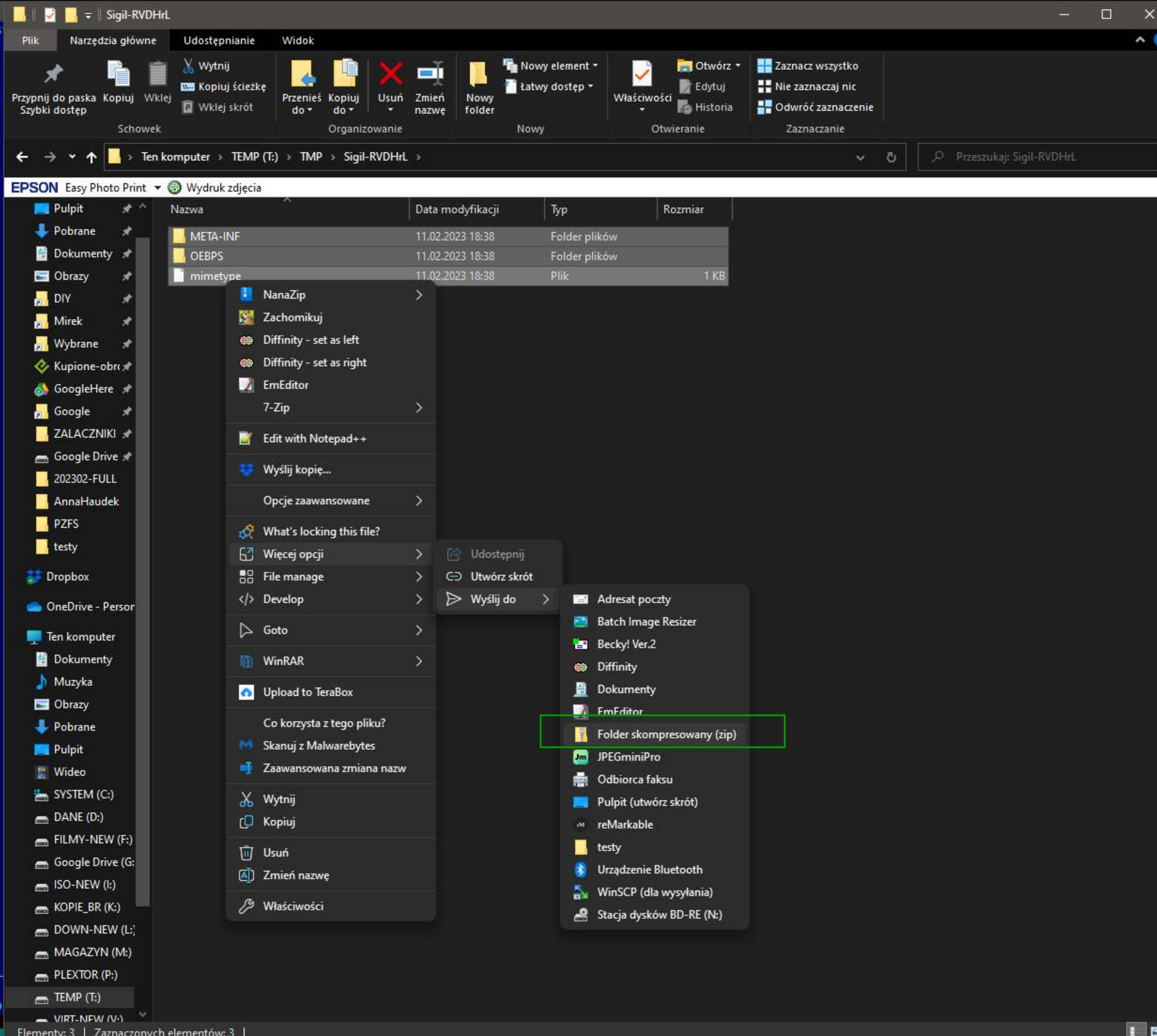


Here you have two options:

1. If you see there
<SIGIL_DEFAULT_TEMP_HOME>
Press **Win+R** (Run), input **%TMP%**
and press **Enter**.
An Explorer window will open
with your temp folder.
2. A different folder path will be written there (copy
it to clipboard)
Press **Win+R** (Run), **paste** full folder path
from Preferences window and press **Enter**.
An Explorer window will open
with your temp folder.



- Find folder with name **Sigil-XXXXXX**
- If there are many such folders – find one that will have the date at the time of your power outage or a moment before that moment.



- Go to folder **Sigil-XXXXXX**
- Select all files and folders
- Right mouse button » Context menu
Send to » Compressed folder (zip)

*...or use your favourite application
for create zip archive...*

- Then will created new archive file
with name **Sigil-XXXXXX.zip**
- Change extension in this file to **.epub**
- Move this file to your working folder
and open Sigil-XXXXXX.epub file
in Sigil.

**If you were lucky – you got your file
back.**
