 How to Read kobo Books on your enTourage eDGe

### Article

NOTE: Before you download a Kobo (or other ebook controlled by Adobe Digital Rights Management) ebook to your PC you will need to have Adobe Digital Editions loaded. See [this article](#) if you need instructions.

Browse to the Kobo website using your PC. Download the e-reader software for your PC if necessary. Select an ebook, then select Download.

The book's .acsm file is downloaded to your PC. Select the file name. Adobe Digital Editions should open.

You can connect your PC to your enTourage eDGe as described in [this knowledge base article](#).

In Adobe Digital Editions, you should see a list of books: borrowed, Purchased, Recently Read, and eDGe. Select the name of the newly downloaded e-book from your library. Drag its name to the eDGe.

The book will be moved in to your library on the enTourage eDGe.

Turn off the mini-usb connection.

To move the book to your library, open the library app.

Open the top left pulldown menu.

Select Storage -->Internal Storage-->Digital Editions.

Locate the new ebook. Select the checkmark next to its title.

At the bottom of the screen, select Add to Library. You can now read the downloaded ebook on your enTourage eDGe.
