How to setup:

1. Download the WebOS Kindle-Import Plugin.zip plugin file.



- 2. Start Calibre by double clicking on its application icon.
- 3. First, you will add two new custom columns in Calibre. Click on the Preferences toolbar icon:





- 4. Click on the Add your own columns button under the Iterface preference category.

- Click on the button to add the *Locations* custom column.
- 6. Enter "locations" for Lookup name, "Locations" for Column heading, and select "Integers" for Column type.

9. Enter "asin" for Lookup name, "ASIN" for Column heading, and select "Text, column shown in the tag browser" for Column type.

- 12. Click on the **warning: Restart needed** window.

15. Next, you will add *Locations* and *ASIN* to the file name template in **Sending books to devices**.





16. Click on the Sending books to devices button under the Import/Export preference category.

30. Click on the **Example 1** button of the **Configure WebOS Kindle-Import Plugin** window to configure the plugin.



31. Select "#locations (Locations)" for **Estimated Locations** and "#asin (ASIN)" for **Generated ASIN**, then click on the **over the custom column changes**.

Click the button to populate the *Locations* and *ASIN* columns for the selected books.
