## Librerator K4NT Shortcut keys

Most of the K4NT shortcuts are combinations with keyboard key (which I'll call ScreenKB in the following text) and some of the other keys available on K4NT. Combinations are to be pressed one key at a time, and not simultaneously. For example, ScreenKB-Menu means you press ScreenKB, then release it, then press Menu. Cursor keys I'll call fw\_up, fw\_down, fw\_left and fw\_right. Fw\_press is the button in the middle.

In readers:

- ScreenKB Right Next Page -> next TOC entry
- ScreenKB Right Previous Page -> previous TOC entry
- ScreenKB Left Next Page -> next bookmark
- ScreenKB Left Previous Page -> previous bookmark
- ScreenKB fw\_up -> add bookmark
- ScreenKB fw\_down -> close book
- ScreenKB fw\_left -> manually set BBox
- ScreenKB fw\_right -> go to ...
- ScreenKB fw\_press -> follow link
- ScreenKB Menu Zoom & Rotate in pdf/djvu, Fonts in CREReader
- ScreenKB Back -> next jump
- ScreenKB Home -> exit Librerator
- ScreenKB ScreenKB -> cancel shortcut and force screen refresh
- **Back** previous jump
- Menu opens Menu
- Home info
- Next Page next page/view
- Previous Page previous page/view
- fw\_up pan up
- **fw\_down** pan down
- fw\_left pan left
- fw\_right pan right
- fw\_press start/end pan in smart zoom modes

## in FileChooser:

- Home go to first page
- Back go to last page
- Menu opens Menu
- fw\_right file/dir info
- ScreenKB fw\_right go to ...
- ScreenKB fw\_up search...
- ScreenKB Menu last documents

- ScreenKB Home -> exit Librerator
- ScreenKB ScreenKB -> cancel shortcut

in lists: (Bookmarks, Highlights, Jump History)

• ScrenKB - delete item

in confirmation dialogs:

- fw\_right confirm
- Back cancel

## in setting BBox:

- ScreenKB set small step
- Menu set normal step
- Home set large step
- fw\_up, fw\_down, fw\_left, fw\_right move crosshairs
- **fw\_press** set corner
- Back cancel
